I help front-end and design teams create world-class digital product experiences by removing friction between concepts and their delivery. I assemble communities to break down knowledge silos and believe high-performing teams produce their best work in collaborative, kind learning environments.

Over the course of my career, I worked on industry-defining design systems at Salesforce and Shopify; led front-end architecture projects at Netflix, BBC, The Guardian, and Financial Times; wrote a book about CSS architecture and design/front-end collaboration; and made more than 50 appearances on stage, podcasts, or conference panels.

- Built a team of AI agents — in response to a CEO AI-acceleration mandate — capable of turning a Figma component into up to 90% production-ready code, built on component and token context contributed by other IDS team members via custom skills and an MCP server.
- Researched and built agentic workflows that accelerated design system creation and consumption. Across 10,000 builders and 20,000 AI agents, projected time savings reach the hundreds of full-time-employee-years annually.
- Modernized the design system's build toolchain — migrating off legacy ESLint, Webpack, TypeScript 4, and Prettier — cutting outer loop time by 67% and inner loops by 50–99%.
- Trained 1,000+ designers, engineers, and non-developers to set up and run AI agents; shipped 124 pull requests across 27 repositories.

- Helped take Netlify's reach from 3 million developers to 5 million developers (and beyond!).
- Worked closely with brand and product design to deliver the 2023 brand refresh, scaling the new design language using design tokens across Figma variables, CSS, and Tailwind CSS.
- When Netlify acquired Stackbit, I aligned their development practices with Netlify's standards — moving the team from a manual 2-week delivery cycle to automated continuous deployments.
- Converted the codebase powering app.netlify.com to TypeScript, and defined internal strategy for AI usage by Netlify developers.

- Started, grew, and managed a team of two developers and a designer looking after Polaris' infrastructure, foundations (icons, design tokens...), and contributor experience (automated visual regression and accessibility testing, developer tooling, documentation).
- Identified Figma as a design tool that would scale with Shopify's growth, and championed a smooth transition for dozens of teams from five legacy design tools to Figma.

Transformed the way dozens of teams prototype, build, and evolve user interfaces, by setting up tools and processes such as Storybook, visual regression testing, and automated accessibility testing — helping the Polaris team scale best practices.
